Miami Gardens, FL – On Friday, April 23, 2021, at approximately 3:30 a.m., The Miami Gardens Police Department responded to a report of a male suffering from an apparent gunshot wound at Northwest 215th Street and Northwest 2nd Avenue. The victim, Mr. Justin Jamal Jackson was transported to a local hospital by the Miami-Dade Fire Department, where he subsequently succumbed to his injuries.

Investigation revealed that the victim and friends had just left a local club. As they exited the parking lot, they were followed by the subject’s vehicle. As the victim crossed Northwest 177 Street on Northwest 2nd Avenue traveling northbound, occupants from the subject’s vehicle began shooting at the victim’s vehicle; there was an exchange of gunfire. The victim’s vehicle fled north and pulled over at Northwest 215th Street and Northwest 2nd Avenue, where emergency personnel were contacted.

The Miami Gardens Police Department is requesting the public’s help with this investigation. There is a Crime Stoppers reward for up to **\$5,000.00** to anyone with any information that leads to an arrest.
